Educated at Brandies University, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, The JTS and University of Pennsylvania (Wharton), Rabbi Paris received many professional honors, including General Agent of the Year Travelers Insurance Company and Quality of Life Award for service to company,

industry, community and humankind, and was chosen as one of the 300 Most Influential Advisors in Defined Contribution for 2009 and 2010 by 401(k) Wire.
