1-Yr Basic Interfaith Minister Comparative Track

The Comparative Religion program is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the world's religions. It involves the study of different religious traditions and beliefs and helps students evaluate how they relate to one another. By exploring various religions and their spiritual perspectives, students develop a broader appreciation for different cultural and individual beliefs. They also learn how to become successful Interfaith Ministers.

Upon completion of the program, students are ordained as Interfaith Ministers and can apply for licensure in New York.

2-Yr Master of Divinity Program (Accredited)

(To enroll in this Master's Program, a student must have already completed an Interfaith Minister course from a recognized Interfaith program.)

This program offers an in-depth learning experience to prepare the student for a spiritual leadership role. The MDiv curriculum focuses on competency and emphasizes Pastoral Ministry, allowing the student to further explore interfaith studies.

Upon completion of the program, the student will receive an accredited Master of Divinity Degree.

2-Yr Doctor of Divinity Program (Accredited)

(To take this Doctorate Program, a student must already be an Interfaith Minister and have an Interfaith Master's of Divinity degree.)

This program strengthens biblical knowledge, theology, and ministry application. A Doctor of Divinity is for those who seek to deepen their knowledge, strengthen their leadership, and build a robust community of peers.

Upon completion of the program, the student will receive an accredited Doctor of Divinity Degree.
